AGED CARE TRAINER

The main purpose of this position is to teach the Aged Care course at our Lautoka center. In addition, the incumbent will be required to supervise students in the clinical areas, take part in the various academic obligations, and undertake any other duties assigned by the Director from time to time.

The Aged Care program is the HECF-accredited National Qualification, the *National Certificate in Aged Care and Community Care [Level 3]*.

Minimum qualifications required for the above position:

A Certificate IV in Aged Care or a minimum of a Diploma in Nursing qualification is a requirement for this position, with demonstrated compliance in the following:

- Minimum of eight (8) years' full time professional nursing clinical experience.
- A teaching certificate or evidence of teaching experience is desirable.
- Hold a current license and good standing to practice as a Registered Nurse in Fiji, or be eligible to obtain a Fiji Registered Nurse license.
- Ability to work effectively as a team member.
- Demonstrate excellent verbal, written, and electronic communication skills.
